



Square 15 - [@themissingyarn](#)



You Will Need

Knitcraft Cotton Blend
Black Yarn A
White Yarn B
Teal Yarn C

Tension

Each square measures approx 20 cm using 5mm hook.

Abbreviations

st(s) stitch(es)
ch(s) chain(s)
tr treble crochet
dc double crochet
ss slip stitch
RS right side

With Yarn A and 5mm hook, 28 ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as first 1tr and 1dc), *1tr in next ch, 1dc in next ch; rep from * along, fasten off and turn after each row.

Row 2: Join in Yarn B, 3ch, (counts as 1 tr), *1dc in next tr, 1tr in next dc; rep from * along, 1dc in top of last 3ch at end.

Row 3: Rep Row 2 using Yarn A.

Row 4: Rep Row 2 using Yarn B.

Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 3 and 4.

Fasten off.



Edging

Using Yarn C, evenly make 25dc along the bottom edge to last st, 3dc in last st, *work 25dc evenly along row ends of side edge working 5 sts for every 4 rows, 3dc in corner; repeat from * twice more ending last repeat with 2dc back into first st of round, ss to join in first dc, fasten off, turn. (112 sts)



Round 2: 1ch (does not count as a st), 1dc into dc around, working 2dc into each center corner st, ss to first dc. Fasten off. (116 sts)

Round 3: With right side facing, join in Yarn B in any stitch, 1ch (does not count as a st), 1dc in each dc around ss into first dc, fasten off.

Sew in ends.

Block if needed.

Daisy

Using Yarn C, 4ch, ss in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: 1ch (does not count as a st), 6dc into the ring, ss to beginning 1ch to join. Fasten off, don't turn.

Rnd 2: Join Yarn B in any dc, 1ch (does not count as a st), [1dc, 3tr, 1dc] in each dc around, ss in first dc to join, fasten off leaving a long-ish strand for sewing on to the square.

Sew daisy on to square.

Sew in remaining ends.
